Job description

The Solvay Brussels School of Economics and Management (SBS-EM) is the Faculty of Business and Economics of the Université libre de Bruxelles, one of the leading research universities in continental Europe. The School prides itself for its programmes that combine scientific rigour, contextual engagement and problem-solving skills. The School invites applications for a part-time position in Audit and Advanced accounting.

The course is meant to be taught in the Spring of the second year of the master. The language of instruction is English.

Educational and scientific goals:

The course aims:

- identifying in the technical literature the relevant guidance regarding recognition, measurement and presentation of transactions and balances in the financial statements under International Financial Reporting Standards (IFRS),
- to get comprehension of the purpose and process of consolidated group accounting and the preparation of consolidated financial statements
- to provide the necessary foundation to define the various steps required to perform an audit of the financial statements of a company in accordance with international auditing standards.
- familiarize students with the planning and execution of financial statement audits through the use of appropriate and substantive audit methods, conclusions and types of report issued.

Qualifications required

PhD Degree (with doctoral thesis) in Economics and Management

Skills required

- Excellent command of English
- Good knowledge in French (B2) -applicants who do not speak French may be granted a period of adaptation, but they must be able to teach in French at the end of the third year following their appointment.
- Strong disciplinary knowledge of audit and advanced accounting
- Teaching experience

- the names and e-mail addresses of five referees (respecting the gender balance) who may be contacted by those in charge of evaluating applications. These referees should not have conflicts of interest because of family or emotional ties.
